# **Notice of Race**

**Blackbeard Sailing Club** is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the Fred Latham Memorial Regatta.

#### 1 Rules

The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the San Juan 21 Class rules, with the following exceptions: Specifications Section 3.4, Article 4 Keel, is amended so the keel shall be placed in the full down position, and the position of the keel shall not be adjusted in any way except to clear any debris from the keel, or to re-float after grounding.

## 2 Eligibility

The regatta is open to the San Juan 21 Class, Working Sails and All Sails. All Class legal sails are allowed.

## 3 Entry and Fees

- 3.1 Register by email by **1800 on Friday**, **12/27/2024** to **sail\_kitty@hotmail.com**.
- 3.2 The regatta registration fee is **\$20.00**.
- 3.3 Lunch will be provided for **\$5.00/person**. Please provide number of people for lunch in your registration email.
- 3.4 Fees must be paid at check-in. Cash (exact change only), check payable to Blackbeard Sailing Club, or charge to BSC member's account will be accepted.

- 1045 Skippers' Meeting
- 1145First signal for the first race
- 1530 Lunch and awards in BSC Clubhouse (Earlier if conditions allow.)

## 5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at the Skippers' Meeting.

#### 6 Courses

Competitors will sail courses as described in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 7 Scoring

- 7.1 Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply.
- 7.2 Three races are planned, but one completed race will constitute the regatta.
- 7.3 There will be no throw-outs. This changes Appendix A2.

#### 8 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded according to the number of entries.

#### 9 Insurance, Safety & Disclaimer of Liability

- 9.1 Each participating boat must be insured with an adequate valid third-party liability policy.
- 9.2 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
